### WARRANTY

Xtracycle U-Tubes are guaranteed to be free from manufacturing defects for one (1) year from the original date of purchase. This warranty applies only to the original buyer and is not transferable. This warranty does not cover damage from use of this product outside of its intended range or that resulting from modification or neglect. It also does not cover wear and tear resulting from the normal use of the product. Please contact your Xtracycle dealer if you believe you have a warranty claim.

## U-TUBES INSTALLATION INSTRUCTIONS

- 1 Remove plugs from Xtracycle horizontal ports. Plugs should come out by hand. Plastic plugs are included as packaging - they are not required when U-Tubes are not installed.



- 2 Insert U-Tube into horizontal ports by hand with the longer end going into the port in the back. The U-Tube should slide easily into tubes. If you are unable to insert U-Tube into holes, readjust rear bridge alignment.



- 3 Like Hooptie, U-Tubes have a narrow setting, and a wide setting. Wide setting will work well for passengering with loaded cargo bags. The narrow setting will work better if bags are not loaded.



- 4 Thread M5 rail securing bolt and lock washer into braze-ons on EdgeRunner frame and through desired setting hole in U-Tube and tighten with a 3mm allen key. Tighten all screws to 6-10 N-m. Do not over tighten. Be careful not to crush U-Tube by threading bolts without proper hole alignment.



- 5 Repeat steps 1-4 on opposite side of bike to install second U-Tube.

- 6 Your U-Tubes are now ready for use.



- ⚠ **WARNING:** Before each ride, check tightness of all hardware - push and pull on all elements of U-Tubes to identify any loose hardware. Listen for rattles or feel for moving parts. U-Tubes should not rattle, and all parts should be firm.
- ⚠ **WARNING:** Always use Hoopties and U-Tubes when riding with passengers not in a child seat.
